

## **THE COUNTRY CLUB OF JACKSON**

### *Site Visit Notes*

**August 5, 2008**

#### **General Notes:**

We have been very fortunate the last couple of weeks with regards to the weather. Although we did have 3<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" of rain this past weekend Eagle Golf was able to complete the remaining greens and were able to have them ready to grass this past Tuesday which was our target date for the remaining greens. We now have to rely on mother nature to provide us with suitable growing weather for the next 60 days and the course should be ready to open.

Eagle still needs to finish the remaining tees on holes #1, 2, 3 (the back tee), 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 14 and 17. With good weather it is still possible we will be able to sprig all the tees with the exception of #17. The determination will be made on Sunday or Monday of next week as to which tees we sod and which will be sprigged.

#### Irrigation

There is still a significant amount of irrigation issues to be addressed in the form of heads that are sticking on due to bad foot valves or debris in the lines. Mark and his crew needs to be certain they have thoroughly flushed the lines prior to installation.

#### Hole Notes:

**#1** This hole is 90% complete. The tees should be ready to sprig by the end of the week. The sloughed sod in the left greenside bunker will be repaired once the greens sprig are watered in for a couple of weeks.

**#2** This hole is 45% complete. The back two tees, the fairway and the fairway bunker still need to be finished and prepped for grassing.

**#3** The back tee is now aligned correctly and can be repaired. The large washout in front of the tee will need to be repaired as soon as Eagle has a crew freed up to do the work. The material that has sloughed into the stream will need to be removed most likely by hand and thrown back up on the bank.

**#4** The back two tees on this hole were not sprigged at the correct rate. As such they will need to have additional sprig added when the other tees are done next week.

**#5** To the right of the tees running parallel to the cart path the slope is not at minimum of 3%. It is imperative that this drains well as this is where the members will be accessing the tees.

**#6** The work done on this hole looks very good. There are a couple of small knots and ridgelines in the green that Stanley and his staff will be addressing which will help reduce or eliminate the likelihood of scalping.

**#7** See #6

**#8** The excess sand around the back two tees needs to be removed and replaced with topsoil like material. This will help when the sod in this area is laid and help reduce the risk of having the subgrade break loose and loosing the sod down the slope. It will be critical of the sod crew to install a significant number of sod staples to help hold the sod on the banks.

The fairway bunker will need to be moved left and made smaller. There will be a need to re-route the existing irrigation. This bunker is more of an aiming bunker however it should be fairly deep in nature. The height of the back of the bunker should be approximately 1' higher than the irrigation head. The depth should be approximately 4'+ deep. The existing bunker should be filled in and graded out to look more natural. Trees will be planted to the right of the bunker once complete.

**#9** The hole is taking shape very nicely the green complex looks very good and fits in well. The left fairway bunker needs to have the one large back side support broken up into two rolls of differing sizes. The left roll should be the larger of the two. Brent has been directed on what to do here.

**#10** The par three is going to be a great hole. The work done is very good.

**#11** The two forward tees need to be lowered. The front of the fairway should be visible from the back tees. Again Brent has been directed as to what to do.

**#18** The back tee needs to be raised 1' for better visibility to the fairway. The material can be generated locally. Champ has been directed on this area.
